2025 WCCC Handbook

A. REGISTRATION / SERVICE DESK

1. The Registration/Service Desk is available for general inquiries regarding room arrangements, meeting and meal locations/schedules, lost and found items, and miscellaneous concerns.
2. The location and availability of the Registration/Service Desk are as follows:

B. CAMPUS PARKING

1. Campus Parking is available at Parking Lot 20 (level 1-4).
2. Attendees are responsible for the parking fee. Parking fee can be paid by downloading the PayByPhone app or through the website: <https://www.paybyphone.com>. Follow the instructions on the app or the website. Lot 20 location number is **398500**.

3. Please observe all traffic and parking regulations. Violators will be personally responsible for payment of fines. The Conference will not bear the financial responsibility for any violation fines.

C. ACCOMMODATIONS

1. Room changes are not allowed.
2. For lodging inquiries (i.e., locked out of the room, room key does not work, etc.) or maintenance needs (i.e., bedding, housing, toilet issues, etc.), contact the front desk in the lobby of the building.

 - Parents have to ensure children are properly supervised at all times during the conference. Please be especially mindful of your children's safety on a public campus.

E. MEALS

1. Meals are served at **Monarca Dining Hall** and **Seven Hills Center**, which are two buildings next to each other and the same food is served in the two buildings.
2. All participants must show their meal ticket (distributed at the entrance) when entering **Monarca Dining Hall** and **Seven Hills Center**.
3. The Dining Center is open for entry during the following hours:

Lunch: (11:15 a.m.) 12:15 p.m. – 1:30 p.m.
Dinner: 5:15 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.
4. Per the University's security requirement, strollers are not allowed in the dining area, only small (stadium) size bags are

allowed. Please do not leave any of your bags on the floor, as they can be a tripping hazard for other people. **Monarca Dining Hall** has designated cubbies at the entrance for attendees to place their bags.

5. To alleviate long lines, please enter and exit once per meal.
6. Food cannot be taken out of the building.
7. As a courtesy to other attendees utilizing the facilities, please vacate the Dining Center as soon as you finish your meal.
